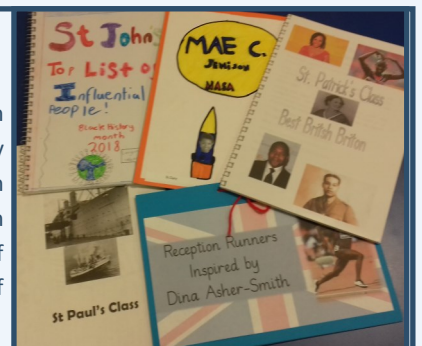

Hamper Mufti

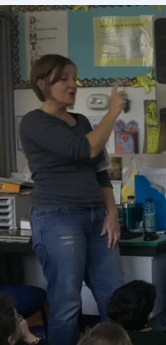
