#### **Happy New Year!**

As we begin 2021, there is a sense of déjà-vu, with the majority of children learning from home and very little activity in school. With systems already in place, however, this time we have been able to get going straight away with online learning. Teachers have been incredibly busy recording lessons and preparing resources for our distance learning platform and we have received some very supportive feedback from families—thank you!

Morning and afternoon registration has been particularly well received, with parents commenting that it helps to give the day structure and is a great opportunity for class groups to come together. If we have not seen a child at a registration session, this will be followed up by a phone call unless parents have already contacted us. Please continue to inform the school if your child is unwell, even if they are learning from home.

We had a streamed assembly this morning, to listen to this Sunday's Gospel and celebrate birthdays. Places are limited to 100 so we ask that families connect to one device only, to enable others to join.

## **Faith Life**




- The Wednesday Word this week is <u>BAPTISM</u>
