## SATs

Next week our Year 6 children will be taking their SATs, the tests that all children take when they leave primary school. The process is formal and children will be taking the tests under strict exam conditions, as required by the Department for Education. The papers will be marked externally and the results sent to us towards the end of term.

We will be providing a breakfast, free of charge, for all Year 6 children at 08:00 Tuesday to Friday next week, so they get a good start to the day. Please note, the breakfast will not be available for younger siblings.

## Attendance and Punctuality

Children make the best progress when they have good attendance. We expect all children to have attendance in the range **97-100%**.

We do not permit leave during term time except in extreme circumstances and it must be requested using the form available from the school office. Where a child's attendance is below 90%, term-time leave will not be authorised.

Attendance below 90% is classed as 'persistent absence' by the Department for Education. If your child's attendance is in that category you may receive a letter from school, inviting you a meeting to discuss improvement.




## World faith
